Makah Fishing Regulation

In-Season Regulation for the On-Reservation Non-Tribal Wa'atch River Rod and Reel Fishery

Year: 2018 **Tribal Regulation Number:** 2018-ON-10
Date: May 16, 2018

Fishery: Commercial, Ceremonial, and Subsistence

Target Species: Trout and other freshwater (non anadromous) species

Management Area: Wa'atch River. From mouth to treeline. Fishing is closed above the treeline. Educket Reservoir and all its tributaries are closed to fishing all year.

Days and Times: Open: 1/2 hour before sunrise, Wednesday, May 16th until further notice. (subject

Bag Limits: 2 Trout per angler, per day. Release all WILD steelhead

Size Limits: Trout- 12 inches

Legal Gear: One hand-held rod & reel per person, No snag gear, no snagging - Eggs & spinner/spoon gear only.
One single point barbless hook. (Hooks less than 1/2 inch from point to shank)

Note: Retained fish must be available to Makah Fisheries Management personnel to collect survey information.

BUYERS: Completed treaty fish tickets must be turned in to the MFM office within 24 hours of landing.
