| Bag Limits: | Two salmon per angler, per day. Any combination of salmon and steelhead. Release WILD Steelhead. | | |
| Size Limits: | None | | |
| Legal Gear: | One hand-held rod & reel per person, No snag gear, no snagging - Eggs & spinner/spoon gear only. One single point barbless hook. (Hooks less than 1/2 inch from point to shank) | | |
| Note: | Retained fish must be available to Makah Fisheries Management personnel to collect survey information. | | |
| BUYERS: | Completed treaty fish tickets must be turned in to the MFM office within 24 hours of landing. | | |
