In-Season Regulation for the On-Reservation Non-Tribal Tsoo-Yess Rod & Reel Fishery

Year:	2019	Tribal Regulation Number:	2019-ON-24
Fishery:	Recreational	Date:	November 4, 2019
Target Species:	Chinook, Coho, and Steelhead		
Management Area:	Tsoo-Yess/c'. yas River. From surf line 200 feet below hatchery weir.		
Days and Times:	Open: Daily, from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset, beginning Tuesday November 5th until further notice. (subject to emergency closure)		
Bag Limits:	Two salmon per angler, per day. Any combination of chinook, coho, or steelhead. Release WILD Steelhead.		
Size Limits:	None		
Legal Gear:	One hand-held rod & reel per person, No snag gear, no snagging - Eggs & spinner/spoon gear only. One single point barbless hook. (Hooks less than 1/2 inch from point to shank)		
Note:	Retained fish must be available to Makah Fisheries Management personnel to collect survey information.		
BUYERS:	Completed treaty fish tickets must be turned in to the MFM office within 24 hours of landing.
