In-Season Regulation for the On-Reservation Non-Tribal Member Rod and Reel Fishery

Year:	2022	Tribal Regulation Number:	2022-ON-15
		Date:	May 20, 2022
Fishery:	Recreational		
Target Species:	Trout and other freshwater (non anadromous) species		
Management Area:	Tsoo-Yess/c'. yas River. From surf line to 200 feet below the hatchery weir Wa'atch River from mouth to treeline.		
Days and Times:	Open: Daily, 1/2 before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset, beginning Saturday May 21st through Tuesday July 5th, 2022. (subject to emergency closure)		
Bag Limits:	2 fish per angler, per day. Release all salmon.		
Size Limits:	Release Trout greater than 16 inches total length.		
Legal Gear:	One hand-held rod & reel per person, no more than 2 hooks.		
Note:	Please follow all current health and safety regulations including face coverings and proper social distancing. Retained fish must be available to Makah Fisheries Management personnel to collect survey information.		

BUYERS: Completed treaty fish tickets must be turned in to the MFM office within 24 hours of landing.
