Makah Fishing Regulation

In-Season Regulation for the On-Reservation Non-Tribal Rod and Reel Fishery

Year: 2022 **Tribal Regulation Number:** 2022-ON-74

Date: November 17, 2022

Fishery: Recreational

Target Species: Coho Salmon and Steelhead Trout

Management Area: Tsoo-Yess/c'u•yas River. From surf line to 200' below hatchery weir.

Days and Times: EMERGENCY CLOSURE: Effective 11:59p.m. (Midnight) November 17, 2022 until further notice.

Bag Limits: Limit: 2 fish per angler per day, any combination of coho or hatchery steelhead.
Release all wild steelhead.

Size Limits: None

Legal Gear: One hand-held rod & reel per person, no more than 2 hooks.
No snag gear, no snagging - Eggs & spinner/spoon gear only.
One single point barbless hook. (Hooks less than ½ inch from point to shank)
No egg sales.

Justification: To protect returning steelhead.

Note: Retained fish must be available to Makah Fisheries Management personnel to collect survey information.

BUYERS: Completed treaty fish tickets must be turned in to the MFM office within 24 hours of landing.
