





Makah Fishing Regulation

In-Season Regulation for the On-Reservation Non-Tribal Rod and Reel Fishery

Year: 2023 Tribal Regulation Number: 2023-ON-31

Date: September 22, 2023

Fishery: Recreational

Target Species: Chinook salmon

Management Area: Tsoo-Yess/c'u•yas River. From surf line to 100' below Tsoo-Yess Bridge.

Days and Times: EMERGENCY CLOSURE: Effective 11:59 p.m. (Midnight) September 22, 2023 until further

notice.

Management Period: January 1 to December 31, 2023

Bag Limits: Limit 2 chinook per angler per day. Release all coho.

Size Limits: None

Legal Gear: One hand-held rod & reel per person, no more than 2 hooks.

No snag gear, no snagging - Eggs & spinner/spoon gear only.

One single point barbless hook. (Hooks less than ½ inch from point to shank)

Other Restrictions: Annual Hook & Line Regulation 2023-ON-4

Justification: To protect returning chinook salmon for hatchery broodstock.

Note: Retained fish must be available to Makah Fisheries Management personnel to collect survey

information.

Fishers are prohibited from tampering with traps affiliated with the Makah Green Crab Program.

BUYERS: Completed treaty fish tickets must be turned in to the MFM office within 24 hours of landing.
