BREAKWATER ROD & REEL FISHERY – NON-TRIBAL MEMBERS

- FISHERY TYPE: Recreational
- TARGET SPECIES: Marine Fish
- CATCH AREAS: Breakwater and Jetty surrounding Makah Marina
- MANAGEMENT PERIOD: January 1st, 2023 through December 31st, 2023
- DAYS & TIMES: January 1st, 2023 through December 31st, 2023
- GEAR RESTRICTIONS: One hand-held rod & reel per person, no more than 2 hooks.
- HARVEST LIMITS: Total of 9 bottomfish per day, subject to the individual limits which follow. **Surfperch and flatfish do not count towards the 9 bottomfish daily limit.**
- Lingcod:* Daily limit 2. **Lingcod retention is only permitted from March 11th to October 21st.**
- Cabazon:* Daily limit 1.
- Rockfish:* Daily limit 7. Anglers may only retain Black, Blue/Deacon, Yellowtail, and Widow Rockfish. The total number of individual rockfish retained may not exceed 7.
- Surfperch:* Daily limit 12. Does not count toward bottomfish limit.
- Flatfish (Dabs, Sole, Flounder):* Daily limit 9. Does not count toward bottomfish limit. **Halibut are NOT included with this flatfish opening.** Halibut do not count toward a flatfish limit.
- SIZE LIMITS: None
- OTHER RESTRICTIONS:
1. Non Tribal Members age 16 years and older MUST purchase a Makah Sport Fishing Permit while fishing in the freshwaters and Marine Areas of the Makah Reservation.
 2. Retained fish must be available to Makah Fisheries Management, Natural Resources Enforcement, and Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife personnel for inspection and collection of survey information.
