## Makah Fishing Regulation

### In-Season Regulation for the On-Reservation Non-Tribal Rod and Reel Fishery

<b>Year:</b>	<b>2023</b>	<b>Tribal Regulation Number:</b>	<b>2023-ON-69</b>
		<b>Date:</b>	<b>November 7, 2023</b>
<b>Fishery:</b>	<b>Recreational</b>		
<b>Target Species:</b>	<b>Chinook and Coho Salmon</b>		
<b>Management Area:</b>	<b>Tsoo-Yess/c'u'uyas River. From surf line to 200' below hatchery weir.</b>		
<b>Days and Times:</b>	<b>Open daily, 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset beginning Thursday November 9th through Wednesday, November 15th, 2023. (Subject to emergency closure).</b>		
<b>Management Period:</b>	<b>January 1 to December 31, 2023</b>		
<b>Bag Limits:</b>	<b>Limit: 2 fish per angler per day, any combination of chinook or coho. Release all steelhead.</b>		
<b>Size Limits:</b>	<b>None</b>		
<b>Legal Gear:</b>	<b>One hand-held rod &amp; reel per person No snag gear, no snagging - Eggs &amp; spinner/spoon/jig gear only. One single point barbless hook. (Hooks less than 1/2 inch from point to shank)</b>		
<b>Other Restrictions:</b>	<b>Annual Hook &amp; Line Regulation 2023-ON-4 No egg sales.</b>		
<b>Justification:</b>	<b>To access surplus returning salmon.</b>		
<b>Note:</b>	<b>Retained fish must be available to Makah Fisheries Management personnel to collect survey information.</b>		

**Fishers are prohibited from tampering with traps affiliated with the Makah Green Crab Program.**

**BUYERS: Completed treaty fish tickets must be turned in to the MFM office within 24 hours of landing.**
