In-Season Regulation for the On-Reservation Non-Tribal Rod and Reel Fishery

Year:	2024	Tribal Regulation Number:	2024-ON-24
		Date:	August 28, 2024
Fishery:	Recreational		
Target Species:	Chinook Salmon		
Management Area:	Tsoo-Yess/c'u'uyas River. From surf line to 100' below Tsoo-Yess Bridge.		
Days and Times:	Open daily, 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset beginning Friday August 30th through Monday September 2nd, 2024. (Subject to emergency closure)		
Management Period:	January 1 to December 31, 2024		
Bag Limits:	Chinook Salmon: 2 per angler per day Release all coho		
Size Limits:	None		
Legal Gear:	One hand-held rod & reel per person, no more than 2 hooks. No snag gear, no snagging - Eggs & spinner/spoon gear only. Single point barbless hooks. (Hooks less than 1/2 inch from point to shank)		
Other Restrictions:	Fishers are required to retain their first 2 salmon and may not continue fishing after attaining their daily limit. Annual Hook & Line Regulation 2024-ON-4		
Justification:	To harvest available chinook salmon.		
Note:	Retained fish must be available to Makah Fisheries Management personnel to collect survey information.		

Fishers are prohibited from tampering with traps affiliated with the Makah Green Crab Program.

BUYERS: Completed treaty fish tickets must be turned in to the MFM office within 24 hours of landing.
