Fishery:	Recreational		
Target Species:	Coho salmon, Chum salmon, a	nd Steelhead	
Management Area:	Tsoo-Yess/c'u•yas River. From surf line to 200' below hatchery weir.		
Days and Times:	Open daily, 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset beginning Friday November 29th through Friday December 6th, 2024. (Subject to Emergency Closure)		
Management Period:	January 1 to December 31, 2024		
Bag Limits:	Limit of 2 fish per angler per day, any combination of coho, chum, or steelhead.		
Size Limits:	None		
Legal Gear:	One hand-held rod & reel per		
	No snag gear, no snagging - Eg Single point barbless hooks. (H	gs & spinner/spoon gear only. Iooks less than ½ inch from point to shank)	
Other Restrictions:	Annual Hook & Line Regulation 2024-ON-4		
Justification:	To access returning steelhead.
