In-Season Regulation for the On-Reservation Non-Tribal Rod and Reel Fishery

Year:	2025	Tribal Regulation Number:	2025-ON-37
		Date:	October 1, 2025
Fishery:	Recreational		
Target Species:	Chinook and Coho Salmon		
Management Area:	Wa'atch River. From mouth to treeline. Fishing is closed above the treeline. Educkett Reservoir and all its tributaries are closed to fishing all year.		
Days and Times:	Open daily, 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset beginning Friday October 3rd through Monday October 6th, 2025. (Subject to Emergency Closure).		
Management Period:	January 1 to December 31, 2025		
Bag Limits:	Chinook and Coho Salmon: Limit of 2 salmon per angler per day, any combination of Chinook or coho.		
Size Limits:	None		
Legal Gear:	One hand-held rod & reel per person, no more than 2 hooks. No snag gear, no snagging - Eggs & spinner/spoon gear only. Single point barbless hooks. (Hooks less than ½ inch from point to shank)		
Other Restrictions:	Retained fish must be available to Makah Fisheries Management personnel to collect survey information. Annual Hook & Line Regulation 2025-ON-4		

Fishers are prohibited from tampering with traps affiliated with the Makah Green Crab Program.

BUYERS: Completed treaty fish tickets must be turned in to the MFM office within 24 hours of landing.
