		Date:	September 3, 2026
Fishery:	Recreational		
Target Species:	Chinook Salmon		
Management Area:	Tsoo-Yess/c'u'eyas River. From surf line to 100' below Tsoo-Yess Bridge.		
Days and Times:	Open daily, 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset beginning Friday September 4th through Sunday September 6th, 2026. (Subject to Emergency Closure).		
Management Period:	January 1 to December 31, 2026		
Bag Limits:	Chinook Salmon: Limit of 2 salmon per angler per day.		
Size Limits:	None		
Legal Gear:	One hand-held rod & reel per person, no more than 2 hooks. No snag gear, no snagging - Eggs & spinner/spoon gear only. Single point barbless hooks. (Hooks less than ½ inch from point to shank)		
Other Restrictions:	Retained fish must be available to Makah Fisheries Management personnel to collect survey information. Annual Hook & Line Regulation 2026-ON-04		
Justification:	To harvest available Chinook salmon.		

Fishers are prohibited from tampering with traps affiliated with the Makah Green Crab Program.

BUYERS: Completed treaty fish tickets must be turned in to the MFM office within 24 hours of landing.
